

CHAPTER 20

CITY ATTORNEY

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20.01 APPOINTMENT AND COMPENSATION. The Council shall appoint by a majority vote a City Attorney to serve for a term of two (2) years. The City Attorney shall receive such compensation as established by resolution of the Council.

20.02 ATTORNEY FOR CITY. The City Attorney shall act as attorney for the City in all matters affecting the City's interest and appear on behalf of the City before any court, tribunal, commission or board. The City Attorney shall prosecute or defend all actions and proceedings when so requested by the Mayor or Council.

20.03 POWER OF ATTORNEY. The City Attorney shall sign the name of the City to all appeal bonds and to all other bonds or papers of any kind that may be essential to the prosecution of any cause in court, and when so signed the City shall be bound upon the same.

20.04 ORDINANCE PREPARATION. The City Attorney shall prepare those ordinances which the Council may desire and direct to be prepared and report to the Council upon all such ordinances before their final passage by the Council and publication.

20.05 REVIEW AND COMMENT. The City Attorney shall, upon request, make a report to the Council and interested department heads, giving an opinion on all contracts, documents, resolutions or ordinances submitted to or coming under

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the City Attorney's notice.

20.06 OPINION ON CONTRACTS. The City Attorney shall, at the request of the Council, offer a written opinion on and recommend alterations pertaining to contracts involving the City before they become binding upon the City.

20.07 PROVIDE LEGAL OPINION. The City Attorney shall, upon request, give advice or a written legal opinion upon all questions of law relating to City matters submitted by the Mayor, Council, members of the Council individually, City boards or the head of any City department.

20.08 ATTENDANCE AT COUNCIL MEETINGS. The City Attorney shall attend meetings of the Council at the request of the Mayor or Council.

20.09 PREPARE DOCUMENTS. The City Attorney shall, upon request, formulate drafts for contracts, forms and other writings which may be required for the use of the City.

20.10 REPRESENTATION OF CITY EMPLOYEES. The City Attorney shall not be paid by the City to appear on behalf of any City officer or employee before any court or tribunal for the purely private benefit of said officer or employee. However, if directed by the Council, the City Attorney shall appear to defend any City officer or employee in any cause of action arising out of or in the course of the performance of the duties of his or her office or employment.

20.11 SEMIANNUAL REPORT. The City Attorney shall make a semiannual report in writing to the Council, which report shall contain a record of every legal matter considered by the City Attorney during the course of the previous six months and the disposition made of all legal matters pending which may interest the City.
